1st step – create your 2022 pledge

To make your pledge online, go to <https://www.luthermem.org/pledge> and fill out the form. When you're done, click on SUBMIT. You will receive a confirmation email. Within five seconds of submitting your pledge, you will be redirected to a Giving page. Follow the steps below to set up your online gift, or exit out.

2nd step – set up your 2022 gift

- First, go to Luther Memorial's website: <https://www.luthermem.org/give/>
- If you have already set up a user email and password, click on SIGN IN.
- If it's your first time, you'll be prompted to complete a one-time REGISTRATION. Once you have registered for your account, a confirmation email will be sent with your login credentials.

For a One-Time Donation

- Choose your fund from the drop-down, enter the donation amount and payment information.
- Review your gift, then click on SUBMIT.
- An email will be sent to the email you listed as a receipt of confirmation.

To Set Up A Recurring Gift:

NOTE: You may use one form to designate multiple recurring gifts if all of the donations use the same payment method.

- Follow the directions above to sign in. Before entering your payment information, under **Your Gift**, click **Recurring** and the red line should move over under that word.
- Choose a fund, and enter an amount.
- Determine FREQUENCY and START DATE.
- Enter your method of payment if it is not saved already.
- Review your gift, then click on SUBMIT.
- An email will be sent confirming the information of your Recurring Gift.

Can't remember your Password?

- From the SIGN IN option, click on Forgot Password and a temporary password will be emailed to the email address you list. Once you sign in with the Temporary Password, it will prompt you to create your own password.
